

## Energy Strategy Targets and Metrics Dashboard

### Note to users

- 1. Reporting of Electricity Consumption and Renewable Generation will move to the Gross Final Electricity Consumption EU RES-E definition for the first time in March 2026 reporting for the 12 months January to December 2025. Trend data will be available from 2018 onwards.**

The Energy Strategy, “Path to Net Zero Energy” published in December 2021 committed to a review of the calculation methodology for the Electricity Consumption and Renewable Generation (ECRG) measure that has been published by the Department of the Economy (DfE) since 2014.

DfE Statistics Information, Analysis and Research Branch sought users’ views on work undertaken to develop an improved statistical measure of ECRG in Northern Ireland and the development of an improved data framework in support. The Department published the Electricity Consumption and Renewable Generation Statistics, Data and Measurement Development: [User Engagement Report](#) on 8<sup>th</sup> January 2026 in which it confirmed that reporting of ECRG will move to a revised calculation methodology for the first time on **5th March 2026**.
