

## **Update on the Northern Ireland Non-Domestic Renewable Heat Incentive Scheme**

As you may be aware, the Economy Minister has indicated his intention to close the Northern Ireland Non-Domestic Renewable Heat Incentive Scheme ('the Scheme').

The purpose of this communication is to provide information to participants on what they should do in relation to their ongoing obligations.

### **Please note, you are not required to become compliant with the obligation to replace or recalibrate your meter(s) after 10 years.**

As it is the Minister's intention to close the Scheme, the Department has decided that you **do not** have to comply with the obligation to replace or recalibrate your meter(s) after ten years. However, you should continue to comply with all other obligations of the Scheme.

### **What do I have to do now?**

There is no immediate change. If you are compliant with the ongoing obligations of the Scheme and consistently provide Ofgem with meter readings, please continue to do that.

### **What if I still have my installation(s) but am not submitting meter readings?**

You should continue to comply with the obligations of the Scheme (except for meter recalibration or meter replacement after 10 years) and ensure you submit an annual declaration and meter readings for any periods you have missed.
